SCRIPTURE VERSE STICKS


These sticks can be used as prompts for reflection and discussion, or they can be used as bookmarks. They could also make a thoughtful Pascha gift.

Cut out the verse rectangles. Wrap them around jumbo craft sticks and glue them in place. You can seal them by applying a thin layer of *Mod Podge*, if you wish. Cut out the envelope template; fold and glue according to the instructions. Keep the sticks inside the envelope.








Flap 2

Step 1

Cut out envelope template

Step 2

Fold Flap 1

Step 3

Spread glue on designated area of Flap 1

Step 4

Fold Flap 2 over Flap 1 and press down to glue together

Step 5

Fold Flap 3 and glue in place

Step 6

Fold Flap 4





THE REPENTANCE CUP

A game to help teach young children about repentance

As mentioned in *Tending the Garden of our Hearts*, when we lead a repentant life, God is able to fill us with His Grace. In this way we are like an empty cup, which is only ready to be filled when repentance is present. This game can help explain this rather abstract concept to young children in a more concrete way. The object of the game is for the player to fill his/her cup by spelling out the word "repentance".

Preparation

- Print out the following page, one for each player, and cut out the cup content pieces.
- Print out the game board, one for each player.
- Print out the letter square page and cut out the squares.
 You will need at least as many REPENTANCE square sets
 as there are players. Place the cut-up squares inside an
 opaque bag (a paper lunch bag works well). The children
 should not be able to see inside the bag.
- ** For sturdiness, all game components can be laminated, or printed on card stock or premium printer paper.

How to play

- Each player receives a game board and a set of cup content pieces.
- For easy access, each player positions his/her cup content pieces on the left side of the game board, on the designated spots.
- Round 1: The first player reaches into the bag and takes out a letter square. S/he positions it on the appropriate spot on his/her game board. Then, she takes the cup content piece of the same color, and places it on the cup, on the designated spot. S/he passes the bag on to the next player, who does the same. When every player has done this, Round 1 is over.
- Round 2: The first player reaches again into the bag. If s/he takes out a new square, s/he places it on the board and continues as before. If s/he takes out a square s/he already has, s/he returns it to the bag and passes the bag on to the next player.
- The game continues in this way until a player completes the word "repentance", thus filling up his/her cup. This player is the winner.









THE REPENTANCE CUP - GAME BOARD
