






MIDDLE FLAP: RIGHT HALF

Fan book

The left half, and the top part of the right half of the middle flap, include two pieces for the Sunday of St. John Climacus:

- A flap book to explore the virtues and passions.
- A fan book to work on the life of the Saint.

THIS PAGE

On each piece, the child writes (or draws a picture of) a characteristic of St. John Climacus or a fact from his life.

Print on sturdier paper for best results. Cut the ovals all around on the solid lines. You can use as many ovals as you wish. Stack the ovals together with the cover on top. Punch a hole on the mark. Fasten with a mini paper fastener. Glue the fan book onto the lapbook.

NEXT PAGE

On the outside of each flap, the child writes a virtue. On the opposite side, s/he writes a corresponding passion. Then s/he opens the flaps and writes a short example from real life. A three-flap option for younger children follows. It is for working on only three virtues and, if desired, offers enough space to draw pictures instead of writing.

Cut the shape out on the top solid line. Cut along the horizontal lines to separate the flaps. Fold the flaps to the center on the dotted line.
