RIGHT FLAP



The right flap includes three pieces for the Great Feast of the Triumphant Entry of our Lord into Jerusalem:

- An accordion T-book to explore ways in which Palm Sunday is celebrated around the world.
- A pocket with cards to work on the icon of the Feast.
- A fan book to work on the Gospel accounts.

Pocket with cards

On the back of each card, the child briefly describes the part of the icon that is shown on the front. Alternatively, they can draw a picture.

Glue this part on the lapbook.

Side tab

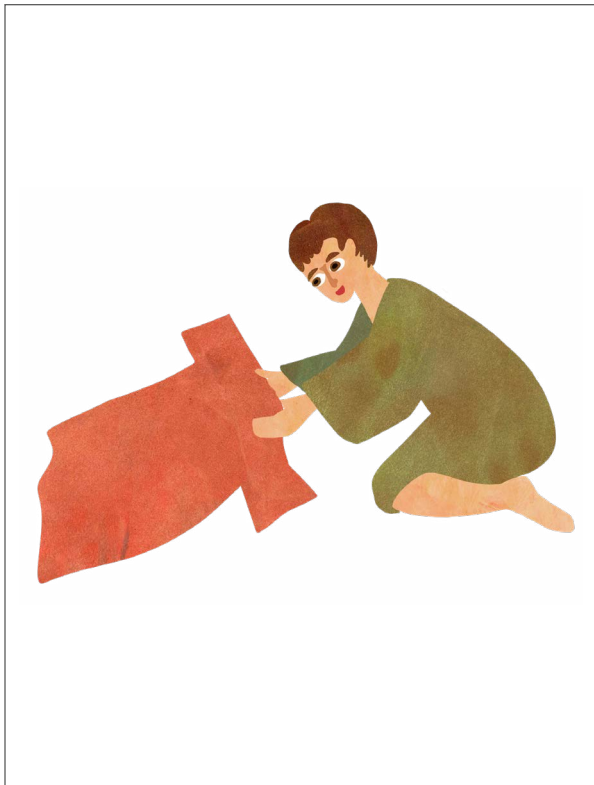
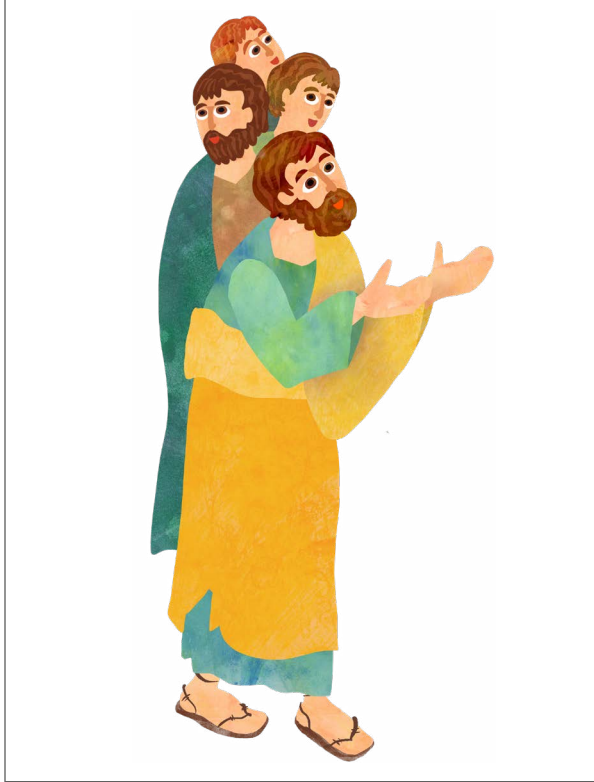

Side tab

Cut the shape out on the solid line. Fold up on the dotted line. Fold the side tabs in and glue them to the back of the pocket. Glue the back of the pocket onto the lapbook. It is best if the cards of the following page are printed on sturdier paper.

Accordion T-book

On each of the four parts of the mini book, the child writes or draws a picture of different ways in which Palm Sunday is celebrated around the world. If desired, the focus can only be on Orthodox countries - or you can choose to explore how Palm Sunday is universally celebrated by all Christians. COVER

Glue this part on the lapbook.

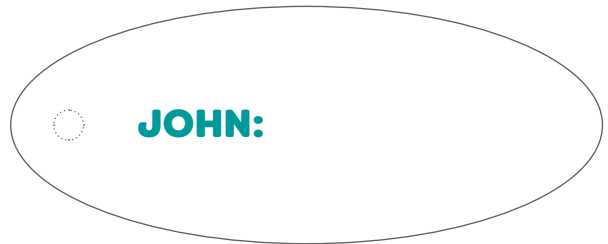
Cut the shape and cover on the solid lines. Fold on the dotted lines. Glue the back side of the T-book onto the lapbook. The top part becomes an accordion which is folded down and covered by the side part. Glue the cover on the outside of the side part.

RIGHT FLAP

Fan book

The Triumphant Entry of our Lord into Jerusalem is described in all four Gospel Books. On each piece, the child writes the relevant verses from each Gospel. It is best to read each story and compare the different accounts.

This activity can be skipped for younger children.



The Gospel accounts are:

- Matthew 21: 1-11
- Mark 11: 1-11
- Luke 19: 28-40
- John 12: 12-17

Print this page on sturdier paper for best results. Cut the ovals all around on the solid lines. Stack the ovals together with the cover on top. Punch a hole on the mark. Fasten with a mini paper fastener.

Glue the fan book onto the lapbook.
